



EAST TEXAS BY NATURE

Fabric Requirements and cutting sizes for 30" x 31" quilt

BACKGROUND FABRIC - 3/4 YARD

Cut 1 -8" strip (salvage to salvage)
1 -16.5" strip (salvage to salvage)

From the 8" strip cut the following blocks:

8" x 14"	Humble Oil derrick
8" x 8.75"	Deer
8" x 6.5"	Mockingbird
8" x 5"	Magnolia
8" x 4.25"	Gecko

From the 16.5" strip cut the following blocks:

13.5" x 12.5"	Pine trees
5" x 16.5"	Sam Houston
6.5" x 9.5"	Egrets
3.5" x 9.5"	Bluebonnet
3.5 x 5	Azalea



SASHING STRIPS AND BORDER - 7/8 YARDS

First cut your 4 border strips 2.5" wide salvage to salvage

Next cut 4 sashing strips 1.5" wide salvage to salvage
From these strips cut the following:

- 2 strips 16.5" long
- 2 strips 13.5" long
- 1 strip 11.5" long
- 2 strips 9.5" long
- 3 strips 8" long

You will not need the sashing and border strips until all the blocks are done, so put these in a bag and set aside until later.

APPLIQUE DESIGNS

All of the designs can be made from scraps. The Sam Houston statue and the Humble Oil derrick would need scraps at least 17" x 7".
